Joshua 21:45 *NLT*⁴⁵ Not a single one of all the good promises the Lord had given to the family of Israel was left unfulfilled; everything he had spoken came true.

Hebrews 6:17-18 *NLT*¹⁷ God also bound himself with an oath, so that those who received the promise could be perfectly sure that he would never change his mind. ¹⁸ So God has given both his promise and his oath. These two things are unchangeable because it is impossible for God to lie. Therefore, we who **have fled to him for refuge** can have great confidence as we hold to the hope that lies before us.

Psalm 119:140 *NLT*¹⁴⁰ Your promises have been thoroughly tested; that is why I love them so much.
